

THE SHROPSHIRE WAY PROJECT ROUTE IMPROVEMENTS

The new route will go to the very top where there are superb 360 deg views from the new toposcope where the old trig point once stood. It then carries on along a permissive path through the old "Dhustone" quarry workings and a short way down one of the longest inclined plains in England. Then branches off and contours the hill to rejoin the original route. A new walk not to me missed.
